### Safe Sport Requirement Initiative Reminder

On Aug. 27, the U.S. Equestrian Federation Board of Directors approved a rule change requiring that effective Jan. 1, 2019, all USEF adult members with a competing membership must complete USEF's Safe Sport Training in order to be eligible to participate in USEF activities. Members can immediately access the free Safe Sport training directly through their member dashboard or can click here to learn more. USEF encourages members to complete the training as soon as possible.

The rule has three main requirements.

- 1. Every USEF member and federation participants shall abide by USEF's Safe Sport Policy and the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code of Conduct.
- 2. In order to comply with S. 534, the Protecting Young Victim's from Sexual Abuse and Safe Sport Authorization Act of 2017, the USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Center's SafeSport Code of Conduct, every USEF adult member and USEF participant, with the exception of the victim, is required to report suspected sexual misconduct within 24 hours to the appropriate authorities and to the U.S. Center for SafeSport.
- 3. Beginning Jan. 1, 2019, every USEF adult member with a competing membership must complete USEF's Safe Sport Training, as approved by the U.S. Center for SafeSport.
